



The Pit	 "The Pit" is the space where teams gather during the competition.
	 Each team is assigned a space (approximately 10' by 10'), containing a table and seating.
	Pit space is limited. Please be considerate.
	• Each table will have a sign showing pit number, team number,
	and team name. The sign <u>must</u> be visible throughout the day.
	Pit maps will be posted.
	 Each team is encouraged to decorate its assigned space – banners, balloons, etc. Freestanding displays are welcome. Any tape used must be "blue painter's tape." No other tape, please.
Behavior	 Teams should plan to be in the official competition areas at all times, except during lunch.
	If an Explore Festival is available, visits are encouraged.
	Pit Managers have the authority to manage pit congestion, pit
	conduct, and pit safety.
Power	Power will be available at shared charging stations.
	• The charging stations should be used as needed to charge
	laptops and/or robot batteries.
	The charging stations are not work areas.
	Please be considerate of other teams.
Spectators	• Spectators are permitted to visit the pits to see the teams' displays and talk to team members, but no spectator seating is available.
Practice tables	 There will be several robot game practice tables for use by teams.
	 These are different from the competition tables and are NOT
	the ones used for the Practice Round.
	 Usage of the practice tables will be will monitored by Practice
	Table Managers.
	 Sign up with a Practice Table Manager for a time slot.
	 These are a shared resource. Please be considerate and
	respectful of other teams.
